- Brush pool walls towards main drain
- Brush pool steps and benches
- Perform routine water testing

- Remove debris from pool equipment deck and pad
- Clean energy filter (if applicable)
- Check filter pressure for appropriate reading
- Observe equipment for correct operation and check for leaks
- Backwash filter system (if needed)
